

Tumaini Fund Canada's Autumn Appeal: Treadle Sewing Machines

\$250 = A Changed Life

One treadle sewing machine costs **\$250** and can change the life of an orphan in Tanzania.

Upon completion of a two-year tailoring course that includes Math and English, each graduate goes home with a treadle sewing machine to set up their own tailoring business to support themselves and their family.

In the second year of the course, tailoring students sew school uniforms for other orphaned students to attend school which helps others, too.

Education is the means to rise up from poverty.



Each of the 5 tailoring schools register 12 students, so **60 treadle sewing machines** are needed for the next class which begins in **January 2026**.

All donations received by **November 30th** will be pooled to purchase the much-needed treadle sewing machines.
